

## 11530 Lusatian ochre

In Lusatia in eastern Saxony, lignite is mined in open pits. To keep the open pits dry, groundwater has to be pumped out. A pit ochre settles in the septic tanks.

This ochre represents a pure warm ochre tone. This glazed ochre could almost be called German sienna, yellow-brown with a warm translucent character.

In Saxony, this color was used in house construction, for example, for the two-tone windows.
